NSW Train Link have train services from Sydney to Goulburn and Bungendore.

Deanes Buslines City Transit run buses from Queanbeyan to Bungendore and Murrays Coaches have bus services from Narooma to Canberra via Bungendore.

Healthcare facilities

Queanbeyan District Hospital is the closest hospital to Bungendore (20 minutes) and has an emergency department and fewer than 50 beds. Bungendore is supported by the NSW Ambulance Service based in Queanbeyan.

Major hospitals in Canberra are only 30 minutes from Bungendore.
