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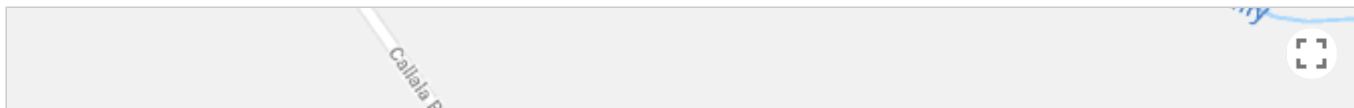
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Callala Bay

Location	<p>Callala Bay is a small town in the Jervis Bay region on the South Coast of NSW. It is located 20 minutes from Nowra and 3 hours from Sydney (about 200 km).</p> <p>Jervis Bay's famous white-sand beaches and clear turquoise waters are amongst the safest and most beautiful in the world.</p>
Transport links	There are no public airports in the Jervis Bay region so if you wish

to arrive by air, you are best to fly into either the Sydney or Canberra airports and connect to Jervis Bay and Callala Bay by road, shuttle or rail. Virgin Australia, Qantas and Jetstar service both airports and car hire and connecting shuttles are available from the terminal.

There are regular City Rail services from Central Sydney that head south passing through Wollongong and terminate in northern Shoalhaven. Alternatively, the CountryLink rail service connects Canberra to Nowra via Albion Park.

Premier Transport and Murrays Coaches both offer several coach services between Sydney and Canberra to the south coast arriving in Nowra. Nowra Coaches run a bus service between Nowra and Jervis Bay.

Healthcare facilities

Shoalhaven District Memorial Hospital in Nowra is a busy acute care facility which provides which provides emergency care, medical, surgical and orthopaedic services to around 22,000 patients each year. The hospital has an intensive care unit that incorporates high dependency and coronary care beds. As well as these clinical services, the hospital has a busy obstetric unit and children's ward.

Shoalhaven District Memorial Hospital is affiliated with the University of Wollongong and the University of NSW. This hospital is fully accredited by the Australian Council on Healthcare Standards (ACHS).

There are NSW Ambulance Service stations in nearby Culburra Beach and Nowra.

Education

There are 13 public schools in the Jervis Bay region. Private schools are available in nearby Nowra.

There are a range of preschool and day care services in the Jervis Bay region.

Shopping

Supermarkets in the Jervis Bay region include the Jervis Bay Supermarket, Coles in Vincentia, Huskisson Supermarket, IGA in Callala Bay and Aldi in nearby Nowra. Huskisson is home to some interesting boutique stores and Nowra has a number of large retail stores such as Kmart and Target and the Stockland Shopping Centre.

Places of worship

There are a number of places of worship in Jervis Bay including Catholic, Anglican, Jehovah's Witness, Baptist, Uniting, and Greek Orthodox churches. The nearest Buddhist temple (Nan Tien) is in Berkeley (80 minute drive) and the closest mosque (Omar Mosque) is in Gwynneville (85 minute drive).
