Crookwell is a picturesque country town situated amid farmland on the Southern Tablelands, high on the Great Dividing Range more than 900 m above sea level.

The nearest airport is at Canberra, a 90 min drive from Crookwell. Canberra Airport is a major airport offering services to state capitals and regional locations.

The Crookwell Bus Service runs between Goulburn and Crookwell three times a day.

Healthcare facilities

Crookwell Hospital is a small regional hospital with an emergency department and less than 50 beds.

Goulburn Base Hospital (35 minutes from Crookwell) is a public district hospital and is operated by Southern NSW Local Health District and serves as a regional referral facility providing a range of general, surgical and some specialist services. It is a teaching hospital affiliated with the Australian National University, based in Canberra.

Crookwell is supported by a NSW Ambulance Service station.
