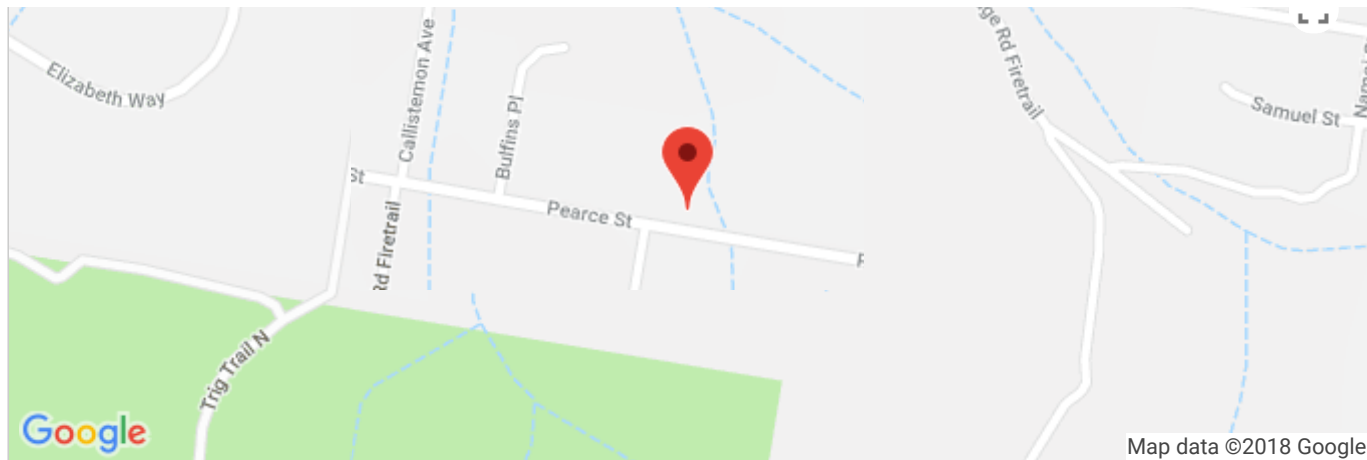

Healthcare facilities

Bowral and District Hospital is an acute care public hospital servicing the Southern Highlands region in New South Wales. The hospital is centrally located in the town of Bowral and is the only hospital operated outside the Sydney metropolitan area by the South Western Sydney Local Health District. It has 94 beds and an emergency department.

There are NSW Ambulance Service stations in nearby Picton and Bowral.

Hill Top offers occasional care, long day care, family day care and [pre-school services](#).

Shopping

Hill Top has a bakery, chemist, general store, liquor store, real estate agent, and fast food shop.

In the broader southern Highlands region there is Woolworths (Mittagong and Bowral), IGA (Bowral and Moss Vale), Harris Farm (Bowral), Aldi (Mittagong and Bowral), Coles (Bowral), Tuckerbag (Moss Vale and Mittagong), and the Robertson and Bundanoon supermarkets. Larger retail stores include Harvey Norman, Retravision, Betta Electrical, Target, Big W and Bed Bath 'n Table.

Places of worship

There are a number of places of worship in Southern Highlands including Catholic, Anglican, Uniting, Methodist and Baptist. The nearest Buddhist Temple (Nan Tien) is in Berkeley (one hour from Hill Top) and the closest Muslim Mosque (Omar Mosque) is in Gwynneville (under one hour from Hill Top).
