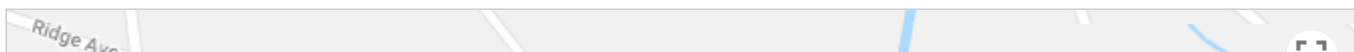

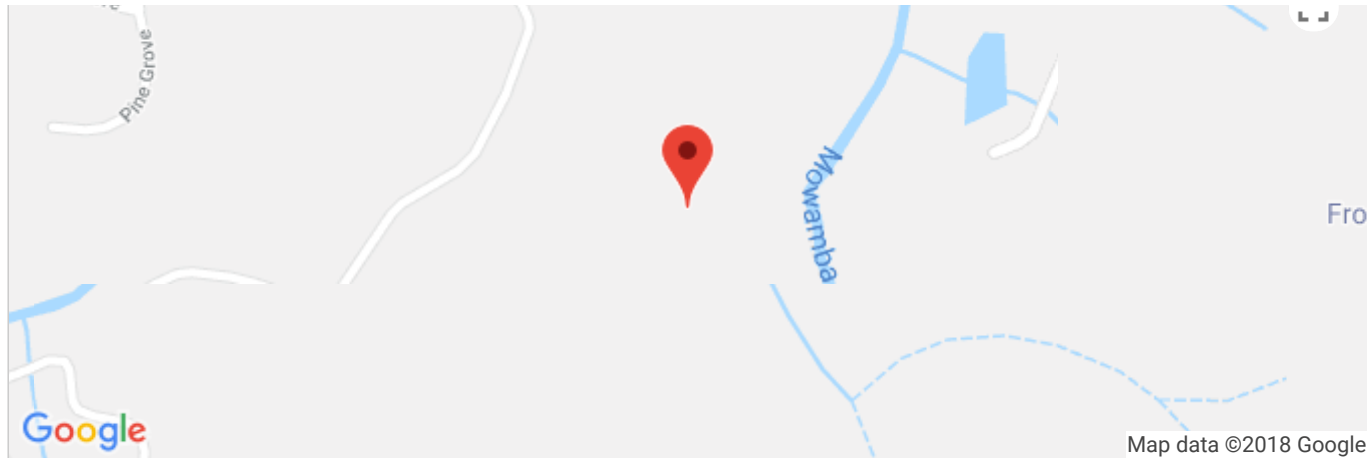

# Jindabyne

The stunning Snowy Mountains town of Jindabyne is located on the edge of Lake Jindabyne.

<b>Population</b>	<p>The population of Jindabyne is more than 2,000 people, the median age is 31 years. Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people make up 1% of the population.</p> <p>Jindabyne is located within the <a href="#">South Eastern NSW Primary Health Network</a>, this <a href="#">Population Health Profile</a> provides an overview of community health for the region.</p>
<b>Location</b>	<p>Jindabyne is located 180km (2 hr 15 min) south of Canberra, via the Monaro Highway. It is 64 km (50 min) from the larger centre of Cooma.</p>

The town overlooks Lake Jindabyne near the Snowy Mountains and is a popular holiday destination, especially in winter, due to its proximity to ski resorts in Kosciuszko National Park, including Thredbo and Perisher.

### **Transport links**

Regional Express (REX) conduct year-round return flights from Sydney into Snowy Mountains Airport in Cooma.

NSW Train Link operates a regional train and coach service that can take you to most key locations around the region including Jindabyne, Cooma, Tumut, Tumbarumba, Berridale, Dalgety and Bombala.

### **Industry**

The main industries people from Cooma work in are:

- Accommodation and food services
- Arts and recreation services
- Retail trade
- Construction
- Education and training
- Public administration and safety

### **Healthcare facilities**

Cooma District Hospital is the nearest regional public hospital (less than 50 beds) with an emergency department and maternity ward.

The closest major regional hospital is located in Bega (nearly 2 hours by car from Jindabyne) and offers:

- 134 overnight beds
- 15 emergency department bays
- 4 emergency medical unit beds
- 46 acute medical inpatient beds

Jindabyne is supported by a NSW Ambulance Service station.

Jindabyne has a small shopping complex anchored with a Woolworths supermarket and a wide range of specialty shops. Being a service town for Australia's highest ski resort it is highly tourist-oriented with a large range of snow-sport rental outlets, bars, restaurants and cafes.

There are a number of places of worship in Jindabyne including Catholic, Anglican, and Uniting churches. The nearest Buddhist temple and mosque are located in Canberra (2 hr 15 min to the north).
