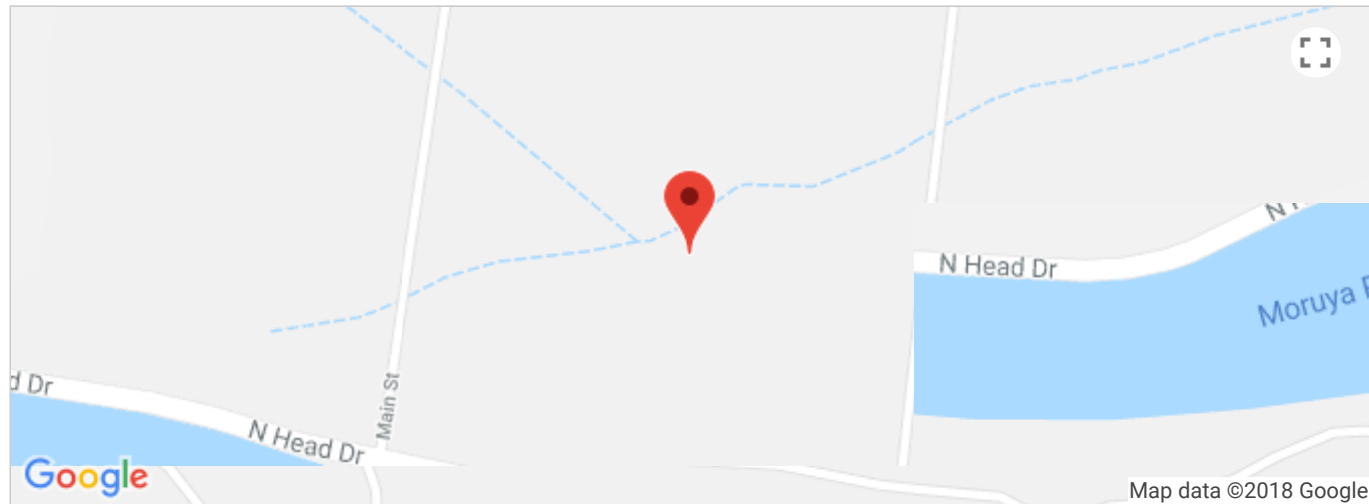

Situated on the banks of the beautiful Moruya River, Moruya has the feel of a country town while being the administrative centre of the Eurobodalla Shire.

Population	<p>The population of Moruya is nearly 4,000 people, the median age of residents is 46 years. Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people make up 8% of the population.</p> <p>Moruya is located within the South Eastern NSW Primary Health Network, this Population Health Profile provides an overview of community health for the region.</p>
Location	<p>Located 305 km (just over 4 hours) south of Sydney and 175 km (2 hours 20 mins) from Canberra, Moruya is surrounded by agricultural land, national parks and waterway.</p> <p>The town is also well known for its quarries that supplied granite</p>

for many significant Australian landmarks including the Sydney Harbour Bridge.

Transport links

Regional Express (REX) offers daily flights to Moruya Airport from Sydney. Flights from Melbourne (via Merimbula) operate Monday to Saturday.

There are a number of coach companies offering daily services to the Eurobodalla Coast from Sydney, Canberra and Melbourne.

Priors Bus Service offers a town bus service between Batemans Bay and Moruya with a range of stops.

Industry

Healthcare facilities

Moruya Health Service includes a 64 bed acute care hospital providing general surgery, general medicine, obstetric, paediatric, oncology, renal dialysis, high dependency care and emergency services. The hospital is supported by Visiting Medical Officer (VMO) specialists and VMO GPs. On-site seven day a week services include radiology, pathology and emergency surgery.

Moruya is supported by a NSW Ambulance Service station.

There are a number of places of worship in Moruya including Catholic, Anglican, Presbyterian and Baptist churches. The nearest Buddhist temples and mosques are located in Canberra (just over 2 hours from Moruya).
