North. Direct flights operate daily to and from Sydney, and weekly to and from Melbourne, with three operators, QantasLink, Tiger Air and Virgin Australia, servicing the region.

Coffs Harbour Railway Station is serviced by the North Coast railway line with six XPT services daily, three heading north to Brisbane and three south to Sydney

The closest hospital is [Coffs Harbour Health Campus](#). It has 292 beds and provides a broad range of specialist services including general medicine, surgery, day surgery, planned and emergency theatre service, coronary care (including coronary angiography unit), intensive care, obstetrics, paediatrics, 24-hour Emergency Department, oncology, palliative care, rehabilitation, stroke, acute renal dialysis, high dependency and mental health and an extensive range of outpatient clinics.

Urunga is supported by NSW ambulance service.

**Things to do**

Urunga has some marvellous beaches for surfing and swimming. Beach and rock fishing are popular in Urunga, and golfers will be delighted with the nine-hole course overlooking the waterways. Other activities include cycling, kayaking, fishing and boating.

The Coffs Coast is a 25 minute drive from Urunga where there are a broad range of entertainment options available from traditional to contemporary to suit all tastes.
