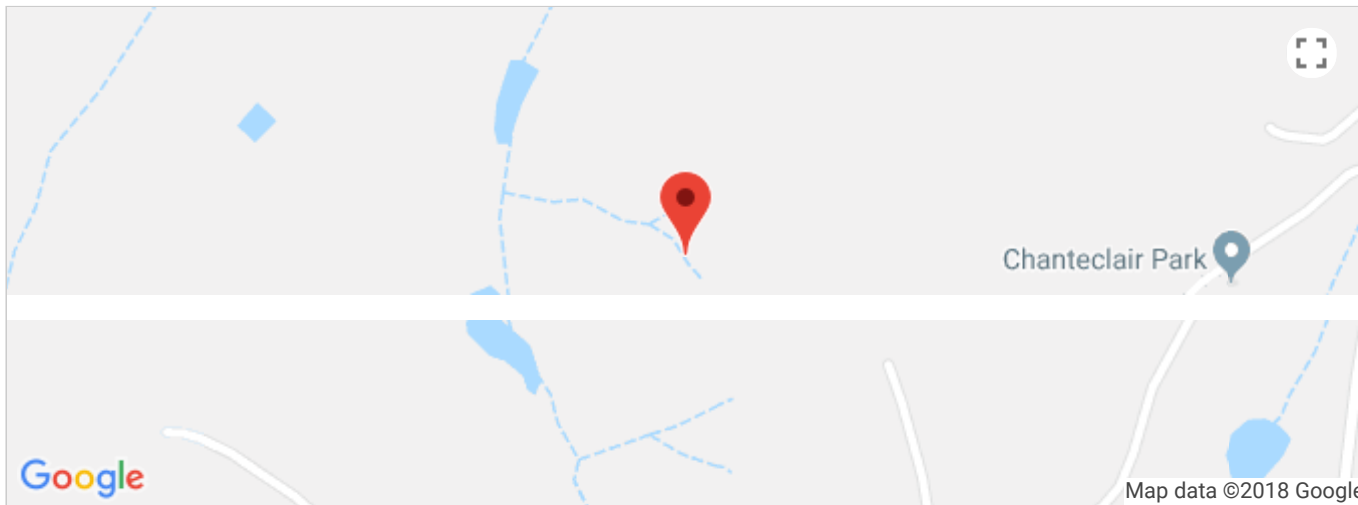

Wallerawang is a small township in the western foothills of the Blue Mountains just 40 minutes from the major regional city of Bathurst.

Population	<p>Wallerawang has a population of 2,000 people, the median age of residents is 39 years. Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people make up 5% of the population.</p> <p>Wallerawang is located in the Nepean Blue Mountains NSW Primary Health Network (PHN). This regional health profile provides an overview of community health for the PHN area.</p>
Location	<p>Wallerawang, or Wang as it is commonly referred to by locals, is a small township in the western foothills of the Blue Mountains.</p> <p>The landscape of Wallerawang is dominated by the local power stations, and the dams that have been built in the area to provide water to them.</p> <p>It is only 15 minutes from the regional town of Lithgow and 40 minutes from the major regional centre of Bathurst.</p>
Transport links	<p>The closest regional airport is in Bathurst, which is a 40 minute drive from Wallerawang, and provides daily flights to Sydney.</p>
Industry	<p>The major sources of employment in Wallerawang are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">MiningHealth care and social assistancePublic administration and safetyRetail tradeAccommodation and food servicesManufacturing
Healthcare facilities	<p>The nearest hospital is Lithgow Hospital and consists of a 46 bed public hospital, a comprehensive community health centre. Also</p>

located on the campus are Lithgow Health Service Community Private Hospital, Three Tree Lodge and Lithgow Health Service Specialist Medical Centre. The Hospital provides 24 hour emergency department supported by on call medical services.

Nepean Hospital at Penrith is the referral centre and is 60 minutes by road.

The nearest Ambulance service is also located 15 minutes away in Lithgow.

The nearby town of Lithgow has three primary schools and two high schools.

The nearby town of Lithgow offers young families [a number of options](#) suitable for children from 6 weeks to school aged, for occasional care, long day care and pre-school.

Shopping

Wallerawang has a Friendly Grocer Store and some boutique retail outlets. It is located just 15 minutes from the nearby town of Lithgow which boasts Coles, Woolworths, Aldi and IGA stores. Lithgow also has a Target and a number of national retail chains.

The major regional centre of Bathurst is just 40 minutes away.

Places of worship

There are many more in the nearby town of Lithgow, the nearest mosque is in Bathurst.
