## 300+ GP registrars have trained in Aboriginal health

Since 2016, 302 GP registrars have trained in an Aboriginal health training facility, with 76% undertaking this training in rural MMM3-7 areas. In the 2021.1 term, 65 registrars are in an Aboriginal health training term, compared to 47 in 2016.1.



## 459,000+ Aboriginal health consultations by GP registrars

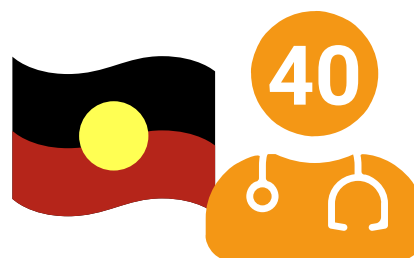
More than 459,000 consultations have been undertaken by GP registrars in Aboriginal health training facilities since 2016. 365,000 of these have been undertaken in rural MMM3-7 locations. On average, each GP registrar undertakes 1,837 consultations per year.
