What travel and accommodation subsidies are available?	GP Synergy subsidises reasonable travel and accommodation for supervisors who are required to travel considerable distances to attend a GP Synergy activity as outlined in the <a href="#">GP Supervisor Professional Development Requirements</a> .
How do I claim my stipend and/or travel/accommodation expenses?	<p>Stipends and travel reimbursement will only be paid upon evidence of participation in the activity (record of attendance) and completion of an activity evaluation within the specified timeframe.</p> <p>After the evaluation period has closed, you will be contacted by our Accounts Department who will ask you to submit an invoice to claim your subsidy and any related expenses (as per the <a href="#">GP Supervisor Professional Development Requirements</a>).</p>
