Stage of training: GP registrars in their first or second GP term training

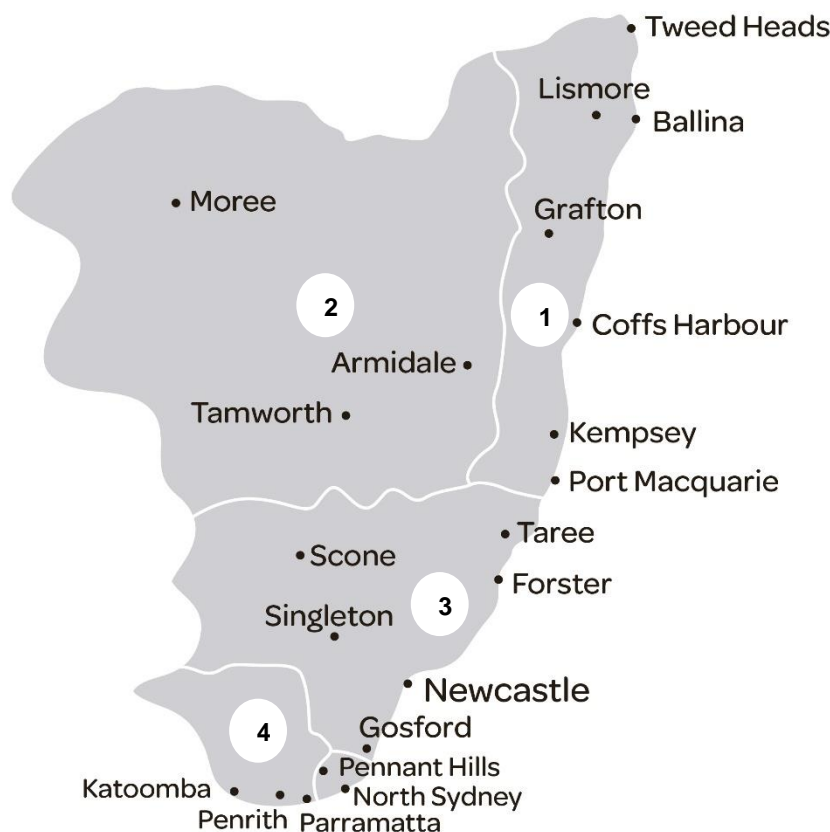
